IMMUNIZATION CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENT - 30-DAY WAIVER

The laws of Georgia (Georgia Code 20-2-771) require a Georgia Certificate of Immunization (on a form provided by the Department of Human Resources) for every student. Students without the required Georgia Certificate of Immunization cannot attend school.

However, the law provides for a waiver of this requirement for 30 calendar days. Based upon your intention to secure the necessary Georgia Certificate of Immunization, your son/daughter is granted a 30-day waiver of the immunization requirement and will be enrolled for 30 days until the expiration date.

The parent/guardian needs to contact his/her physician or local health center immediately in order to obtain the necessary certificate. The Fulton County Health Centers are open during registration for your convenience. Take the student and any immunization records you have to a physician or health center.

If you successfully obtain the appropriate Georgia Certificate of Immunization, then the certificate should be taken to the school immediately, but in all cases, within 30 days.

Unless a Georgia Certificate of Immunization is submitted by the date required, the student must be withdrawn from school until such time as the required certificate is submitted to the school. (For out-of-state transfers, Georgia law provides a possible waiver extension under strict provisions while immunizations are being received. Contact the principal or Student Services for details.)

I understand the conditions under which my child is being enrolled in school and know he/she will be withdrawn after 30 days if a Georgia Certificate of Immunization is not submitted.

EAR, EYE, AND DENTAL SCREENING - 120-DAY WAIVER

Georgia State standards require that schools have on file a Certificate of Ear, Eye, and Dental Screening (Georgia Department of Human Resources Form 3300) for all kindergarten students, first grade students and those students new to Georgia. Your child is new to Georgia schools this year, and therefore must meet this requirement.

I understand the state requirement for an Ear, Eye, and Dental Screening and agree to provide the school with this certificate (Form 3300) within 120 days of today's date.
